- 3. Dr Yadav an ophthalmologist talked on 'Eye care and eye donation' for the senior women citizens belonging to unorganized sector from the Shruti Mahila Gujarati Mandal, Mumbai. Even a free Eye Check –up was arranged for them.
- 4. Prof Prabhakaran, Prof in the subject of economics talked on (12<sup>th</sup> September:): "How to Plan your finances" for the women of Shurti Mahila Gujarati Mandal. He conducted the programme as SEBI coordinator and explained different types of investment plans for the purpose of maximum benefit.
