WDC REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES (Year 2019-20)

The College has Women Development Cell which is constituted as per the University of Mumbai Guidelines. The Women Development Cell functions accordingly and arranges programmes for students and staff every year to sensitize the students on gender related issues.

The following is the list of activities arranged in year 2019-20:

- 1. Lecture on Gender Sensitization was arranged for the students on 26/06/2019. It was attended by 69 students.
- 2. Seminar on 'Skin and Hair Health and changing trends in adolescent behavior' was organized for students on 22/06/2019. Total 63 students attended the seminar.
- 3. Seminar on 'Awareness on Gender Issues and its Relevance' was arranged for the students on 12/07/2019. Total 90 students participated in the seminar
- 4. Students presented Research Paper on the topic 'Trials and Trivia of Women's life' on 31/07/2019.
- 5. Essay writing competition on the topics 'Women and law, 'Women Empowerment through education', 'Women and Safety' was organised in September, 2019 in which 10 students participated.
- 6. Guest lecture on 'Police and you know your Right' by Mr. Dolphy D'souza was arranged for the students on 9/12/2019. Total 69 students have attended the lecture.
- 7. Session on Fashion Illustrations and Design by Lemark School of Arts and Design was arranged on 09/01/2020 in which 45 students attended the session
- 8. 6 students participated in one day seminar on "Sexual Harassment at work place" organized by Chandrabhan Sharma College on 28/01/2020.
- 9. Workshop on 'Constitution of India and Empowerment of Women' was arranged for the students on 22/02/2020 in which 57 students have participated.
- 10. Women's Day was celebrated on 8/03/2020. Total 47 teachers and students participated in the programme.



- 11. Two days intercollegiate conference on 'Gender Sensitization & Legal implications Eve Teasing & Teens' was organised on 11/06/2020 and 12/06/2020. Advocate. Shweta Agrawal and Advocate Allveen Marque were invited as guest speakers for conference. 524 teachers and students attended the conference.
- 12. National level webinar on 'Gender equity & Covid-19: Mental Health Concerns' was arranged on 16/07/2020. MS. Pooja Nai & Ms. Leena Poojari were guest speaker for the webinar. 197 teachers participated in the webinar.
