Poster Making Competition on Conserve Energy- Solar Power

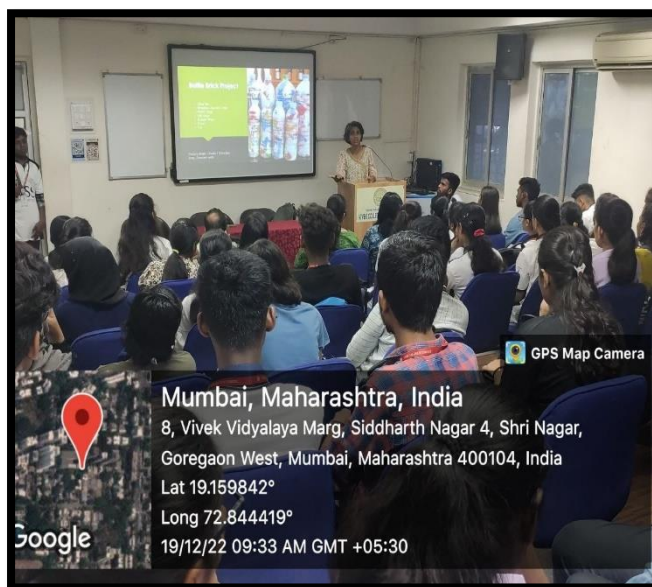

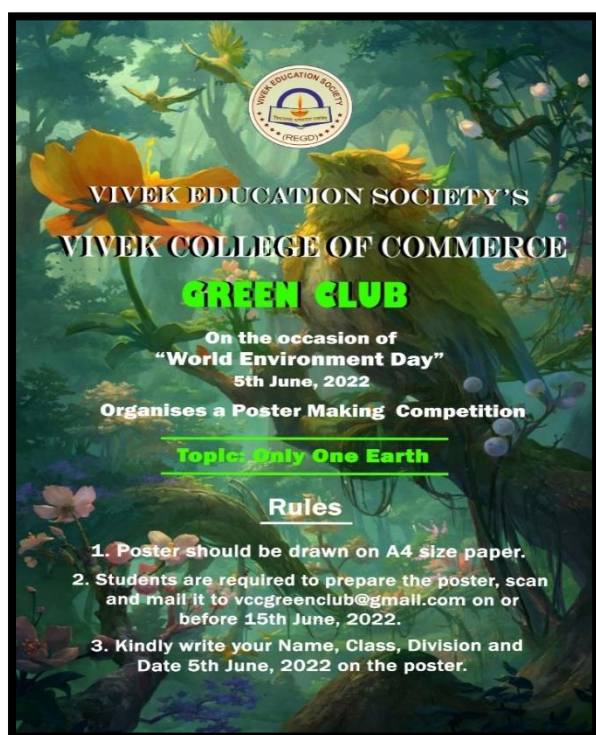
